

### Open-Air in Remote Villages

**Robert Moffatt**, a celebrated missionary back in the 1800s, once gave an address in which 20 particular words were used by God to send David Livingstone to Africa. He said, "I have sometimes seen, in the morning sun, the smoke of a thousand villages where no missionary has ever been." Today, 220 years later, these very villages in northern Kenya are still mostly untouched with the Gospel. These are the fields of ministry in which OAC Kenya is currently active. Hundreds of nomadic tribal people gather to watch the Jesus film and listen to the Good News preached. Wherever possible, a pastor comes for the follow-up outreach. Also, in the local schools leading up to the recent time of COVID, hundreds of students have attended our assembly programs.
