Poland



OAC Norway began praying for Poland in 2020 to start a branch there. Only 1% of the population in Poland are evangelical Christians. Because of this, there is a great need for evangelists who can preach the gospel in this predominantly catholic country.

In 2022, national director Hartvig Kloster from OAC Norway began visiting contacts in Poland to initiate the search for an evangelist to start the work. He made several trips there and began building a network, including yearly mission trips with groups from Norway ministering in Poland. The experience from these trips was that people in Poland are open to discussing faith and that open-air events work well in Poland. In this process, Hartvig met a young man whom he trained to become an OAC evangelist; however, the young man later decided to focus primarily on youth in his church. But through him, Hartvig established contact with Jakub Kon. Jakub joined Reach the City Oslo in July 2025 to become acquainted with OAC. This young man has had a calling to evangelism from God since he was 14 years old, and he possesses numerous valuable qualifications and a genuine heart for it. He has been involved in open-air ministry on his own in Katowice, using his megaphone, while continuing his vocation in the IT field, but now feels called to quit his job in 2026 and start working as the new national director and evangelist in OAC Poland. Jakub is married to Magda, and they have a daughter named Abigail. They live in Tychy, near Katowice in southern Poland.


